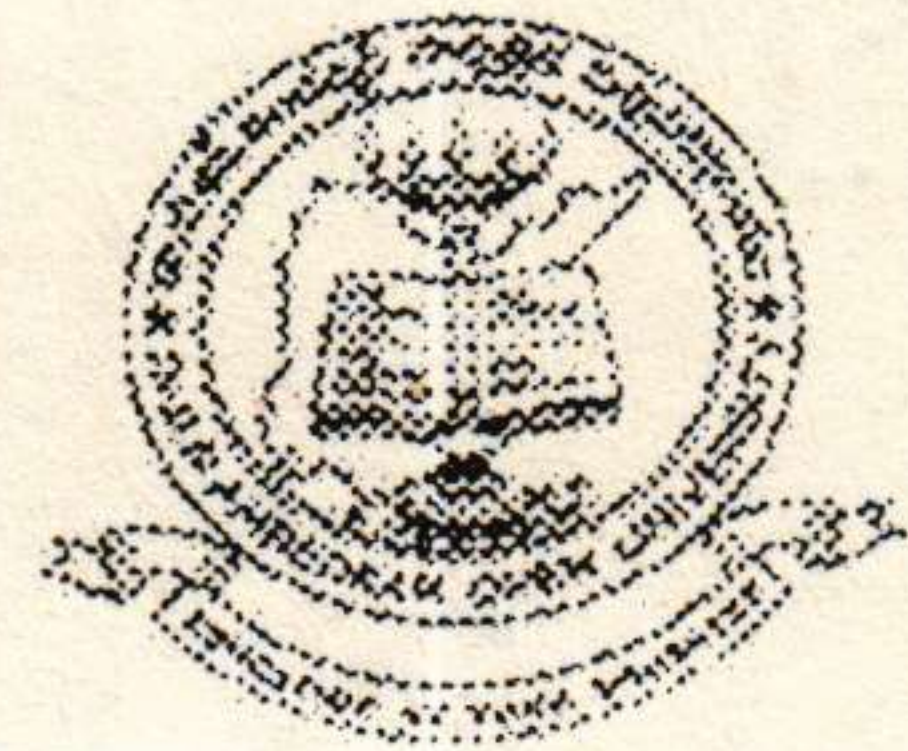
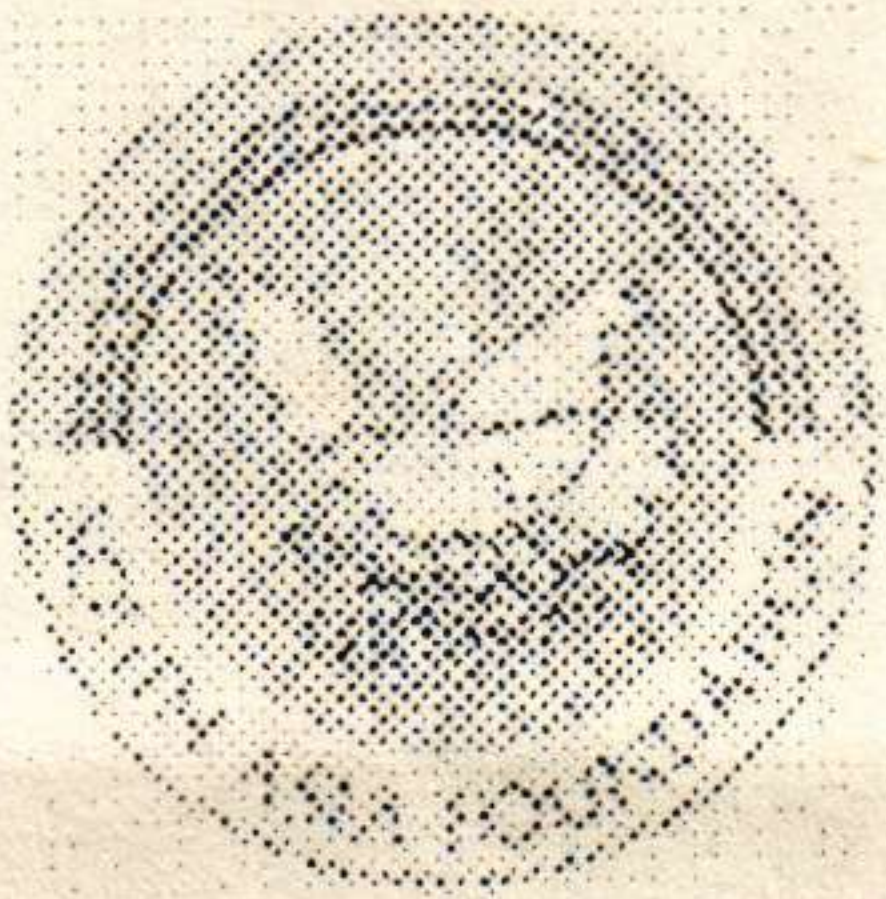

In conformity with the decisions regarding SAF Madanjeet Singh Scholarships for Postgraduate programmes and Vocational Training programmes for the marginalized South Asian students with social and economic disadvantages taken by the SAF Distance Learning Academic Council and approved by the SAF Chairpersons at a meeting held on 14th December 2003 in New Delhi, India, (hereinafter referred to as "New Delhi Resolutions").

SAF and BRAOU wish to enter into this agreement in regard to the SAF Madanjeet Singh Scholarship programme.

Article 2

Beneficiaries of the Programme Participants

The scholarship programme shall be open to nationals of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka for Postgraduate programmes and Vocational Training programmes. Students from economically and socially disadvantaged backgrounds shall be selected on the basis of their academic record and an interview, while maintaining gender equality and ethnic balance on an institutional basis. Applicants must not exceed the age of 30. Students already doing higher studies are not eligible for scholarships.

As regional cooperation is the cardinal objective of South Asia Foundation

BRAOU shall organize an orientation meeting of selected students before the commencement of the programme arrange a mid-term seminar to make students aware of the merits of regional cooperation establish a statutory requirement that before the diplomas/certificates are awarded the scholar help in enrolling at least 30 colleagues to SAF membership which is free. The cost incurred on this shall be borne by the concerned university/institution.

Article 3 SAF Membership

Applying for scholarships shall be subject to SAF membership which is free of cost. Each member should sign a pledge stating that a dynamic South Asian culture of peace and democracy can emerge only through promotion of regional cooperation, nourished with the energy and idealism of youth.

Article 4 Funding

The total number of scholarships per year shall be determined as stated in **schedule 1**. Every year one third of the Scholarships shall be reserved for fresh students within this overall limit. The scholarship amount per scholar shall be equivalent to US \$ 300 per annum.

Disbursement of scholarships shall be through the Chairpersons of SAF-India on the basis prescribed in the guidelines as in **schedule 1** (annexed).

Article 5 Administration

1. BRAOU shall be responsible for all co-ordination of the Scholarship Scheme within ANDHRA PRADESH, liasewith the Chief SAF Scholarship Co-coordinator at the Indira Gandhi National Open University and with the SAF-India. The cost incurred shall be borne by the concerned university/institution.

BRAOU shall organise and conduct interviews of the candidates applied for scholarship in association with SAF- India. The cost incurred on conducting interviews shall be borne by the concerned university. The cost incurred by the SAF India representative on interviews will however be borne by SAF- India.

3.

BRAOU shall communicate the names of selected candidates to the Chief SAF Madanjeet Singh Scholarship Coordinator for India at the Indira Gandhi National Open University. The Chief Coordinator shall process the cases and verify that norms have been duly followed before recommending names to SAF India Chapter.

4.

BRAOU while advertising the programmes eligible for scholarship will make a mention of the availability of SAF scholarships for those programmes.

5.

BRAOU will advertise separately once a year about the availability of SAF Madanjeet Singh Scholarship and include a logo of SAF in the advertisement.

Article 6 Commencement of the Agreement

The agreement shall become effective on the date upon which the Parties append their respective signatures to it.

Article 7 Duration of the Agreement

The administration of the SAF Madanjeet Singh Scholarship Scheme shall be continuously monitored jointly by the SAF-India and BRAOU SAF shall have the right to discontinue the scholarship scheme if the BRAOU fails to strictly adhere to the prescribed criteria.

Article 8

Variation of the Terms of the Agreement

The terms of the agreement may be modified if and when required by consent of the parties hereto and the SAF.

Article 9

Early Termination of the Agreement

1. Either party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement by providing the other party with three calendar months advance notice. Such termination shall take effect at the end of the course in progress at that time.


Article 10
