WHEREAS BRAOU established through the University Acts passed by the A.P. legislative Assembly (1982 and 1993) has the mandate to provide access to higher education to large sections of the hitherto unreached population by democratising and

WHEREAS both the parties hereto agree that by pooling their physical, human and infrastructural resources and by working together mutually to synergise their activities would be able to draw on their mutual strengths in realizing their individual and common goals and objectives to contribute to the fulfillment of their mandates;

The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding with the intention of being bound accept the following terms and conditions :

1. BRAOU approached the Kakatiya University for permission to construct building in the premises of University Arts & Science College, Warangal to house their Regional Co-Ordination Center (RCC) to use the modern communication and satellite technologies in the teaching learning processes. BRAOU requested that land admeasuring 500 Sq.yds be identified to construct BRAOU building to house the Regional Co-Ordination Center.


2. The Location of the building in the host college will be decided with mutual consultation and the approval of the Kakatiya University.
3. BRAOU would have no claim now or in future for the ownership of the land and the ownership of the land would be retained by the competent authority of the Kakatiya University.
4. BRAOU would construct a building and use the finances within the budget provisions of the University. The University will equip the building with furniture and down linking facilities for teleconferencing and provide other infrastructural facilities to have a wide area network connecting the headquarters with the Regional Co-ordination Center.
5. BRAOU shall ensure that the activities of RCC would not disturb the activities of the host college.
6. BRAOU would have the complete ownership of the building and the furniture equipment and apparatus procured through University Funds.
7. BRAOU agrees to share the down linking facilities with the host college where the RCC building is located on days where the BRAOU will not be using the facilities and without detriment to the normal working of the RCC.
8. The letter vide reference No. 451/DEV/2004 dt : 16-11-2004 addressed by the Registrar, Kakatiya University to the Registrar, Dr. BRAOU forms part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
9. Any changes in these terms and conditions will be resolved through mutual consultations and consensus.


