

AGREEMENT FOR OFFERING THREE P.G. DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

An agreement is made on the 15th day of August Two thousand five between the Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University, Road No.46, Prof. G. Ram Reddy Marg, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad – 500 033 represented by the Registrar of the said University (hereinafter called "BRAOU" and this expression shall include his successors and assignee) on the one part, and the Lifetime Wellness Rx International Limited of Apollo Hospitals Education and Research Foundation, Plot No.35, Avenue – 1, Sai Enclave, Road No.12, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad – 500 034, represented by the Managing Director (hereinafter called LWRIL and this expression shall include his successors and assignee) on the other part.

Whereas BRAOU, established under APOU Act, 1982 as amended in 1992 has the mandate of catering to the needs of the country with the objectives of democratizing higher education by taking it to the doorsteps of the learners irrespective of their age, region or formal qualifications.

Whereas LWRIL an Apollo Hospitals Group Company registered under Companies Act, 1956, with main objective to carry on business of delivering health care services and the business of establishing an educational platform for conducting Health, Healthcare Education and allied programmes.

- 2. The advertisement in the News Papers regarding these 3 P.G. Diplomas shall be released with the names and Emblems of both the Institutions viz., BRAOU & LWRIL. The cost of the Advertisement will be borne by LWRIL completely.
- 3. The Prospectus, Application Forms, Course Material etc. will be printed by LWRIL with the names and emblems of both the Institutions.
- 4. The fees will be paid by the students to LWRIL and out of it 10% will be given to BRAOU by LWRIL. LWRIL cannot increase or decrease the fees without consulting BRAOU.

- 5. Except the conduct of Examinations and issuing of marks memos & P.G. Diploma Certificates all other aspects such as Admissions, printing and posting of Course material to the students, valuation of Assignments, conduct of contact classes etc., shall be looked after by LWRIL. The P.G. Diploma certificates will be issued by BRAOU by mentioning in the certificate that the students have undergone complete training in LWRIL in collaboration with BRAOU.
- 6. Examinations are to be conducted in the identified centres only. The students have to complete any P.G. Diploma Programme within a stipulated time of three years from the date of joining.
- 7. The facilities regarding the electronic media i.e., shooting of Video Lessons, conduct of Live Teleconferences, Live Radio Phone-in programmes, Recording of Radio/Video Lessons shall be provided by BRAOU. For Teleconferences, the total expenses are to be borne by LWRIL. The honorarium for the resource persons for all these activities is also to be paid by LWRIL.
- 8. The rule of reservation shall be followed if the number of candidates applying for the P.G. Diplomas exceeds the number fixed for admission to the P.G. Diplomas by both the institutions.
- 9. The coordinator and other staff of LWRIL shall contact the Registrar for all administrative and policy matters.
- 10. From BRAOU side, Dr. M. Ramachandraiah, Professor of Botany shall act as the coordinator of these three P.G. Diploma Programmes and these programmes shall be under the over all control of the Dean, Faculty of Science, BRAOU.
- 11. As par of social responsibility BRAOU shall offer two free seats (for S.C. and S.T. students) every year in each programme. The candidates shall be selected purely on merit basis by BRAOU from among the candidates who have applied for.
- 12. Any dispute arising out of the above agreement shall be within the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad Courts only.
