AGREEMENT 199 AGREEMENT 199 RABAD (SOUTH) DIST.

This agreement is made on 12th of November, 2022, Two Thousand Twenty Two, between the Secretary acting on behalf of the Media Academy of Telangana State Chapel road, Nampally Hyderabad. (hereinafter called the MATS) which expression shall include its successors and assignees on the one part, and the Registrar, acting on behalf of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University, Road No.46, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad – 500033 (hereinafter called BRAOU) which expression shall include its successors and assignees of the other part.

Whereas the MATS wishes to collaborate with BRAOU in offering of the M. A. Journalism and Mass Communication programme,

It is hereby agreed as follows:

- In consideration of the agreement to collaborate with MATS and BRAOU agree that MATS shall sponsor a maximum of 25 candidates for the M.A. Journalism and Mass Communication programme in every academic year by paying 50 per cent of programme fee on behalf of the candidates. The candidate shall pay the remaining 50 per cent.
- This collaboration shall be for an initial period of three years from the date of this agreement.

- iii. BRAOU will supply to the candidates sponsored by the MATS learning packages as used by the students of its PG programme.
- iv. The MATS shall assist in the identification of subject specialists / experts / practitioners to be invited as resource persons for the special lectures / Audio Visual materials development, etc. The honorarium, travel and other allowances will be decided in consultation with MATS.
- v. BRAOU and the MATS may explore the methodology of organizing short duration training programmes / workshops / seminars for working journalist, The details regarding the organization, financial commitment, development of training material would be worked out separately.
- vi. The M.A. Journalism and Mass Communication degree will be awarded by BRAOU on successful completion of the programme.
- vii. The MATS shall institute ONE media research fellowship worth Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh only) for a journalist. The awardee will paid Rs. 30, 000 per month for a period of three months Rs10,000/-may be used for selection process etc and the programme shall be monitored by BRAOU.
- viii. Designated officers from the two parts shall monitor the implementation of the MOU and modifications, if any, from time to time.

The Agreement may be renewed with mutual consent of both the parties after expiry of the three years period.

All other rights are reserved with the University.
