Memorandum of Understanding Between Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad And SETWIN (A Govt. of A.P.Society), Hyderabad.

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered on this 4...... Day of oc. to be 2002 by and between:

- Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Open University, an Open University established through an act of A.P.State Legislature its Head Quarter at Hyderabad, Hereinafter referred by DRBRAOU.
- SETWIN, a Society for Employment Promotion and Training in Twin Cities, established in the year 1978 by Government of Andhra Pradesh, with its head office at No 4, Azmath Jah Palace, Purani Haveli, Hyderabad, hereinafter referred as SETWIN.

Whereas:

- The Parties hereto shall hereafter engage in further discussion and 5. work together to finalize all the details, so that the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) can become operational in the academic year 2002-2003.
- This MOU shall come into force from the date of execution hereof by 6. both the parties and shall remain valid for a period of three years. On expiry of the validity period, both parties may renew the MOU subject to the terms and conditions that may be agreed between the parties.
- This MOU outlines the broad understanding between the parties and is not a legally binding contract on either party.
- However, the MOU can be altered, revised, changed, extended or 8. terminated with prior notice of three months by either party with the provision that the promise made to students under this MOU by
 - Either party, will be fully honored to take care of any imponderables, which are likely to be revealed in any dynamic situation, the parties, hereby, agree to remain constant consultation on the principle of "advise and consent"

This MOU does not grant any right to either party any license or right 9. to use any of the IPR of the other parties such as trademark patents, whether registered or otherwise.

SETWIN

- 1. BRAOU is an Open University with a primary objective of making higher education accessible to all across the barriers of space, time and location
- 2. SETWIN is a Society established in the year 1978 by, Government of Andhra Pradesh, with a view to impart training in Skill Development Programmes, I.T. & Management Programmes and Self Employment Programmes for the educated UN-employed youth so that they can live on their own feet. Today SETWIN has established 19 Training centres in twin cities and 96 Computer Franchise centres and 56 Non-Computer Franchise centres in Andhra Pradesh.
- 3. BRAOU has agreed to have collaboration with SETWIN to provide employment generation courses to the Women Learners in the following skill development programmes.
 - Pre-Primary Teacher Training
 - . MS-OFFICE-2000
 - Diploma in Hotel Management
 - Fashion Designing
 - Beautician

4. SETWIN has agreed to :

- Extend a special 30% concession for women learners of DRBRAOU registered in the above programmes in the fee normally charged for such programmes.
- Extend a special 50% concession for learners of DRBRAOU who are Physically Handicapped and also for Slum dwellers in the fee normally charged for such courses.
- To setup franchises at all Regional Co-ordination Centres and some Study Centres, SETWIN would enter into Franchise with DRBRAOU.
- The students of SETWIN who wish to pursue their education through BRAOU would be encouraged to register with BRAOU. BRAOU would provide the learning material and conduct of the examinations and declare the results. SETWIN would provide face to face counseling in a flexible method. Select SETWIN Centres would be treated as recognised learning centres of BRAOU. The student tuition fee will be shared between BRAOU and SETWIN on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- The Women Learners from twin cities of DRBRAOU registered in SETWIN programmes will attend for the training in select of the SETWIN training centres located in twin cities.
