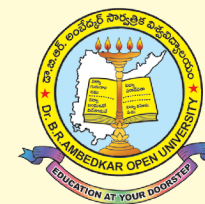

## About the University

The University initially known as Andhra Pradesh Open University, was setup on 26<sup>th</sup> August 1982 (through an Act of State Government). Subsequently, it was renamed as Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University in 1991. This University, the first of its kind in India, heralded an era to provide opportunities of higher education to all sections of the society to meet the changing individual and social needs. It has opened up portals of higher education to home makers, farmers, skilled and unskilled labour, prisoners and others. The motto of the University is 'EDUCATION FOR ALL'. Altogether about 40 educational programmes, that include Bachelors, Masters, Professional, Diploma and Certificate programs have been provided by the University. All the programmes offered by the University are recognized by the U.G.C., New Delhi. At the time of inception, a three-year B.A. Economics course was started, later post-graduation. M.A. Economics was introduced. This apart, the University is conducting M.Phil and Ph.D. Research Programmes. By now, the University has entered into 41 years (1982-2023) of its dedicated services to its learners.



## Department of Economics

The Department of Economics as a part of Dr. B R Ambedkar Open University came into existence in 1982. The subject was first offered in B.A (Programme) both in English and Telugu media and from 1996 onwards M. A. in Economics was also offered. The Departmental faculty's multiple areas of specialization has encouraged multifaceted research at the Department and added some depth to the PG courses. Subsequently, Research programmes: M.Phil. and Ph.D. were introduced from the academic year 2008-09. Some of the Broad Research Areas include – Agriculture, Banking, Development Economics, Rural and Tribal Studies.

## About the Seminar

Welfare Programmes have a crucial role to play so long as inequalities in income and wealth exist in the society and, certain segments of society do not have easy access. The Government of Telangana, in addition to some of the Welfare Programmes in vogue, has initiated a number of Welfare Schemes to improve the livelihoods of different sections of the population.

The Government of Telangana is dedicated to enhancing the welfare of the society and economically underprivileged, including women, children, senior citizens, people with special needs, and members of Scheduled Castes (Scs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), Backward Classes (BCs), and Minority Communities. The purpose of the welfare schemes is to ensure that they reflect the needs of the relevant communities.

In this context, the Department of Economics is organising a two-day national seminar on “Evaluation of Welfare Schemes in Telangana State” on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2024.

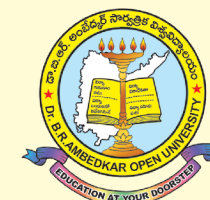
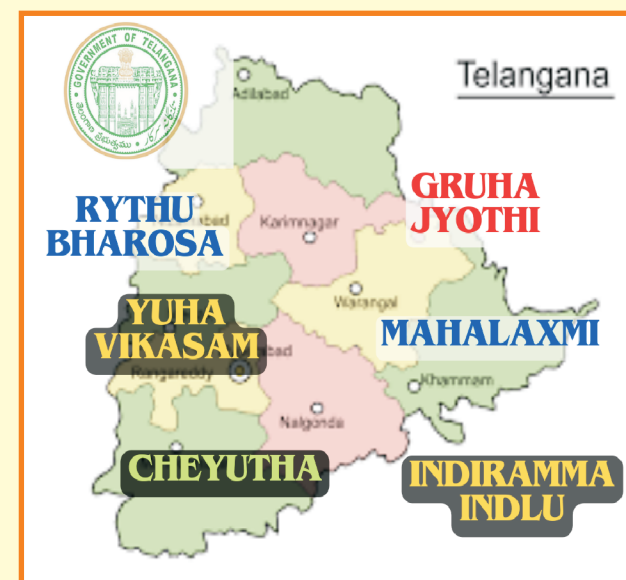
