Introduction

Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University is the first Open University in India, established in 1982. Completed 42 years of its existence. In these 42 years of journey, the university has tried to fulfil the objectives of the university laid down in the Act. We have a rich collection of materials in audiovisual form as BRAOU is the first Open University to have a special Audio-Visual Research and Production Centre since 1983. It is now renamed as the Electronic Media Resource Research Centre (EMRRC).

Our first digital initiative started with the spirit of Open Educational Resources (OER) movement and as a first step developed an Institutional OER policy with the support of CEMCA (2018) and created OER Repository called *VIDYAGANI*. Thousands of Audio and Video lessons are placed in this repository. Special lectures reviewing the journey with experts in the field of Open and Distance Education (ODE), conducted as Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Memorial Lectures, Prof.G.Ramreddy Memorial Lectures and University Foundation Day Lectures, the University Convocation addresses are also made available in this repository. Rare books in our library known as Narla Venkateshwar Rao collection, are in the process of digitisation to give access to our learners as well as general public.
