Recognition to BRAOU Programmes

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University (BRAOU)
Hyderabad initially known as Andhra Pradesh Open
University was established through an Act of A.P. State
Legislature (APOU Act 1982).

It was inaugurated by the then President of India, Late Sri Giani Zail Singh on August 26, 1982. Subsequently, the University was renamed as "Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University" by the Government of Andhra Pradesh during Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centenary Celebrations in the year 1991. The University Grants Commission (UGC) New Delhi also admitted this University for assistance under Section 12-B of the U.G.C. Act Vide UGC Letter no. F5-7/82 (CPP) Dt. 12-05-1986.

Further, the University has received recognition

- A) For offering Programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode for the Academic Year 2018-19 onwards (F.No.1-6/2018 (DEB-I) Dt. 03-10-2018 for 27 Programmes.
- B) Permission to start M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes from 2017-18 (F.No.2-1/2017-DEB-III, Dt.21-3-2017)

The University is also a Member of the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi; Asian Association of Open Universities, Association of Commonwealth Universities and International Council for Open and Distance Education.

Vidya Yeravdekar, Pro Chancellor, Symbiosis International University, Principal Director, Symbiosis, Pune, Maharashtrawas the chief guest & keynote Speaker at the 42nd Foundation Day Lecture at Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad. Prof.(Dr.) Vidya Yeravdekar, delivered a Lecture on "Internationalisation of Higher Education- Issues and Challenges". She said 2023 for India represents 73 years of constitutional democracy, 32 years of economic liberalisation, and concentrated reforms in our educational system. Each one of these achievements is significant as India moves toward becoming not only a strong and prosperous economy, but also a nation known for its academic excellence globally. The recent National Education Policy of 2020 however, has taken the need to offer a globally strong and relevant Indian Higher education ecosystem, to new heights. The National Education Policy -2020, let me step back and talk a bit about the reforms of 1991 which paved the way for this new policy to be imagined and more specifically paved the way for Internationalisation of Higher Education. Widely regarded as an all-

encompassing and innovative vision document for 21st-century India and its educational ecosystem, NEP 2020 addresses pivotal dimensions of education, ranging from Multidisciplinary and Holistic Education, Research, Innovation, and Entrepreneurship, to Governance and Teacher Capacity Building, Quality, Ranking, and Accreditation, Digital Empowerment and Online Education, Equitable and Inclusive Education, Promotion of Indian Languages.

Prof K. Seetharama Rao, Vice-Chancellor, BRAOU presided over the program. Prof.Rao said the Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Open University completed 4 decades of services to cause of Distance Education in this movement of retrospection, it would be not out of place to recall with pride some of the achievement of the university during its educational annals of the both States. Ambedkar Open University (BRAOU), Prof.G.Ram Reddy Centre for Research and Development (GRCR&D) in collaborations with Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR-SRC) Hyderabad organized a two day national seminar on "Exploring the Contributions of the Unsung Warriors in Freedom Struggle – Contemporary Relevance" on August 23, 2023 at the University Campus.

Smt.Surabhi Vani Devi, MLC, attended as chief guest for the program, she said that the research

conducted in the universities should be useful to the society, especially to bring out the struggles of the women fighters who participated in the freedom struggle, and hoped that the research should be an inspiration to the future generations of the female power of those days. The fighters who participated in the freedom struggle should be invited and speak in the universities and they should be honored, She also said that such things give the youth a great feeling. She explained that Swami Ramananda Theertha is one of the greatest freedom fighters in history.





Prof.Rama Melkote, Former Hear, Department of Political Science, Osmania University, Educator and renowned writer, Keynote speaker of the program said that many people hear about Indian freedom fighters but do not find them in

books. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the author of the Constitution, was not widely publicized until the 1980s, and his great way of thinking was widely known to the people of the country with the struggle of the Dalit communities. Telugu female heroes like Chakali Ailamma and Mallu Swarajyam have not received enough recognition, historians and writers want to focus on their struggles.

The Guests of Honour Dr. Ayachitam Sreedhar, Chairman, Telangana Grandhalaya Parishad said that if foreigners wrote the stories of Indian freedom struggle, the situation would be unknown. He said that there is a lot of history that we don't know and researchers need to uncover it and save it in books.

Prof K. Seetharama Rao, Vice-Chancellor, BRAOU presided over the program. Prof. Rao wished to continue research in universities to uncover the history, culture and war stories of the fighters. Historians should continue research to eradicate the social ills in the society, remove superstitions and make people aware.

Dr.A.V.R.N Reddy, Registrar also spoke on the

occasion. Prof.E.Sudha Rani, Seminar Director, explain the aims, objectives of the program. She explained the need and necessity of organizing this workshop. It has been revealed that many social

science teachers will participate in this two days seminar and guide the research students. All Directors, Deans, Heads of the Branches, Teaching and Non-Teaching staff, Representatives of services associations, Research Scholars & Students are participated in the proram.

KALOJI'S MODEST LIFE IS IDEAL FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS

BRAOU News, September 20, 2023: Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University organized Sri Kaloji Narayana Rao Memorial Lecture as part of 109th Birthday Celebrations on September 20, 2023 at its campus.

The Chief Guest Dr.Ravulapati Sitharama Rao, Associate Professor of Telugu, SR& BGNR Government Degree College, Khammam delivered the lecture on "Constitutional Morality - Kaloji's Poetry and Personality". Dr Ravulapati said that Kaloji's life is full of values. Kaloji fought the development of the society till the end with his straightforward writings. He explained that Kaloji was a public poet, a poet of struggle and passion. He said that Kaloji's poetry used to question the irresponsibility of the people, it used to remind them of responsibility from time to time, and it used to question the mistakes made by leaders in relation to contemporary politics. On the one hand questioning the leaders and on the other hand warning the enforcers of the laws, he used to obey the laws himself as a responsible citizen. He explained that he was very fond of the constitution and wished that the thought processes of the leaders should be within the scope of the state. It is stated that the language used by the people along with the Telangana language and slang are the dialects used in Telangana villages. He said that if he gets angry on any matter, he will criticize your face regardless of whether it is big or small. Kaloji's modest life is ideal for future generations.

Prof K. Seetharama Rao, Vice-Chancellor, BRAOU presided over the program, he said Kaloji stood in the front row among Telangana veterans, and reminded that during his life, he had the philosophy of Telangana language, Telangana accent and the separate statewood for

Telangana. It is stated that Kaloji's writings were the lifeblood of the Telangana movement.


