Recognition to BRAOU Programmes

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University (BRAOU) Hyderabad initially known as Andhra Pradesh Open University was established through an Act of A.P. State Legislature (APOUAct 1982).

It was inaugurated by the then President of India, Late Sri Giani Zail Singh on August 26, 1982. Subsequently, the University was renamed as "Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University" by the Government of Andhra Pradesh during Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centenary Celebrations in the year 1991. The University Grants Commission (UGC) New Delhi also admitted this University for assistance under Section 12-B of the U.G.C. Act Vide UGC Letter no. F5-7/82 (CPP) Dt. 12-05-1986.

Further, the University has received recognition

- A) For offering Programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode for the Academic Year 2018-19 onwards (F.No.1-6/2018 (DEB-I) Dt. 03-10-2018 for 27 Programmes.
- B) For offering Master of Business Administration (MBA) two years, and MBA Hospital & Health Care Management for the Academic Year 2018-19 (F.No.1-6/2018(DEB-I) Dt.03-10-2018.
- C) For offering B.Ed and B.Ed(SE) Programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode for the Academic Year 2018-19 (F.SRC/NCTE/APSO6242/B.Ed (DE)/AP/2018 90290,Dt.06/10/2018 & F.No.10-4/Policy/2012/RCI, dt. 15-10-2018.
- D) Permission to start M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes from 2017-18 (F.No.2-1/2017-DEB-III, Dt.21-3-2017)

I am particularly happy to have the gracious presence of our Honourable Chancellor, Sri. E.S.L. Narasimhan who is known for his excellence in State Administration, intelligence and above all a scholar of eminence to grace the convocation.

It is a great honour and privilege to welcome the eminent Chief Guest of the day, Padma Shri, (Prof.) Goverdhan

Mehta. Goverdhan Mehta is a recipient of the Indian Government's Padma Shri Award.

The ceremony of Graduation has been regarded by Eleanor Roosevelt, as "an exciting time. It marks both an ending and a beginning; it's warm memories of the past and big dreams for the future. She also mentions, "the future belongs to those who believe in the beauty of their dreams". I congratulate all the Graduate, Post Graduate students and Research

Scholars of the University who receive Degrees and Awards at this convocation.

Nadia Murad, the recent Nobel Prize laureate has asserted that "Education plays an essential role in nurturing civilized societies that believe in tolerance and peace. Therefore, we must invest in our children because children, like a blank slate, can be taught tolerance and co-existence instead of hatred and sectarianism." Education is the basic means in removing gender bias; reduce poverty and is that which solves a number of other severe confrontations of the society. Education improves the socio-economic productivity and global development.

India has a time-honoured model of Higher Education totalling 903 Universities of which 46 are Central Universities, 351 are State Universities, 343 are Private Universities and 123 are Deemed Universities. Out of the 365 State Universities, 14 are State Open Universities. The Indira Gandhi National Open University is categorized as a Central University. Apart from the 14 Open Universities, 110 dual mode Universities offer programmes through Distance mode. Some institutions of India such as Indian Institute of Science and IITs have been globally acclaimed for their standards of education. In spite of the best efforts of the Government, the Gross Enrolment Ratio of the country still remains at 25.08% for 18-23 age group (MHRD, 2018) which is below the world average of 30%. In such a scenario, it is vital to remark that the enrolment through ODL stream in the nation has increased steadily over the years exceeding the enrolment figures of conventional universities. The contribution of ODL to Gross Enrolment Ratio is 11%.

The 12th Plan Document has fixed targets of 30% Gross Enrolment Ratio by 2020-21. In order to increase the enrolment in higher educational institutions, various measures have been taken by Government, viz.,

 Issuing of new UGC regulations for Open and Distance Learning that allow entry of reputed institutions to offer education in distance mode. Using of ICT technology-SWAYAM portal to reach out for people and allow them to secure good quality education.

Improving the regulatory mechanism, developing quality benchmarks for ODL programmes and recognition of the ODL programmes on par with those of conventional universities are some of the measures suggested by the Commissions for promotion of the ODL system in the country.

Ladies and Gentlemen, I am happy to report to you that following our last convocation held in 2018, our university has - in this short span - persistently maintained a high visibility and recognition as an institution that upholds values of high quality education and research.

At this Convocation, 33,487 candidates, who have qualified during the year 2017-2018, are receiving their Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates. Out of these, 33,487 candidates, 28,922 are UG candidates who have qualified to receive their degrees among whom 43% are women. 96 prisoners from various prisons of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States are also receiving degrees at this Convocation. I congratulate all of them once again.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

The Extension Activities form an association concerning the University and the community. Our university is constantly engaged in extension activities through its curricular and extracurricular activities.

The Women's Development & Extension Centre (WD&EC) of the University is established with the objective to serve the needs and aspirations of the women learners and women employees. During the period under review, WDEC has celebrated International Women's Day. "Women Education Empowerment" and "Different Issues Faced by Women" formed the centre's endeavour to uplift women's status. The centre also organized Bathukamma Celebrations on the campus to promote the culture of Telangana State.

Dr BRAOU also organizes various Extension lectures on the contribution of various eminent personalities to the education system. Some of the lectures – are conducted in honour of personalities like, Dr. B. R.

Ambedkar, the father of Indian Constitution, Sri. P.V. Narasimha Rao, Prof. G.Ram Reddy, Prof. S. Bashiruddin, Kaloji Narayana Rao, Acharya Kothapally Jaishankar and so on. Further, the university organizes lectures in connection with the University Foundation Day and National Science Day. The University takes every opportunity to invite visionaries and exemplary personalities to provide the teachers, employees and students an exposure to the socio-economic and cultural issues.

TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION

As digitalism is moving ahead, higher education institutions globally are employing technologies to offer online programmes, multimedia instruction, Massive Online Open Courses and promoting the usage of Open Educational Resources. Apart from design and delivery of the courses, technologies are increasingly utilized for administrative purposes including online admissions and conduct of examinations.

Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University, since the beginning has embraced multimedia teaching-learning approach. The self-learning course material is supplemented and complemented with audio-video lessons and live teleconferences. The university has a well-equipped Audio-Visual Production & Research Centre, which facilitates the delivery of technology-mediated courseware for the benefit of learners. Radio Lessons are broadcast through All India Radio from 6:25 pm to 6:40 pm every day. Video Lessons are telecast through Doordarshan from 5:30 am to 6:00 am from Monday through Friday every week. Further, video lessons are telecast through MANA TV from Monday to Saturday every week from 12:15 noon to 1:15 pm.

The University has introduced Online Admissions into various programmes. A separate portal (www.braouonline.in) has been developed to access the application form for registration for various programmes. The Computer Centre had developed online registration form for certificates (Provisional-cum-Consolidated Marks Memo, Migration, Transfer Certificate and Original Degree) to facilitate the students to get their certificates soon after the completion of their course.

The University has a well laid out website, which provides information about different branches, programmes on offer, fee structure, admissions, faculty, results, RTI manual and all other activities held in the University. The University has undertaken the process of upgrading the website with a view to enable the visually challenged students also to use it without any hindrance.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

While the Student Services Branch of the University conducts admissions into various courses and ensures smooth functioning of the study centres, the Material Production branch of the university engages itself in printing and distribution of the course material to the students. The branch is an important and vital segment of the support services. Further, it is responsible for purchases and maintenance of Computers, Printers, Scanners, Xerox and other machinery.

The University always places the learner at the centre of all its activities. In order to keep the learner informed of various audio, visual lessons, counselling classes etc., the university, from time to time, sends SMS alerts to the students.

The University has started a Model Study Centre in 2017, housed in the University Campus. It has gone down well with the other centres recording a clear improvement in the services offered at the study centres.

To support the educational needs of students, faculty and other staff, the University Central Library was established in the year 1983. The library is housed in a two-storey building with state of the art facilities. The Library has a total collection of over 1,49,965 books and other documents. In addition, the library has endowment sections with a valuable collection of around 20,000 books. The library is fully automated and all the departments & faculties are provided access to the Online Public Access Catalogue through the Local Area Network. The library has Internet connectivity and several workstations are provided for users to comfortably browse the Internet. Library has plans to open up the collection to all the students with minimum fees and to work in extended hours in shift system to promote the use of the library by the

students. Plans are afoot to organize outreach programmes to create awareness of library; to create repositories and digital network stations to facilitate quality research.

UNIVERSITY FINANCES

The University has a UGC-DEB Affairs & Campus Development Cell, which looks after liaison with funding agencies like Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission; Commonwealth of Learning; Department of Science & Technology and other Research organizations

During the financial year 2017-18, the University has received a Block Grant (Grant-in-Aid) of 1412.32 Lakhs and an amount of Rs. 300.00Lakhs as Development Grant from the Government of Telangana. For 2017-18, the receipts and payments of the university were Rs. 8976.44 lakhs and Rs. 8598.03 Lakhs respectively.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Infrastructure constitutes the basic physical facilities needed for the operations and activities of the university. BRAOU is located on a panoramic elevated site of 53.63 acres in Jubilee Hills. The University houses impressive buildings, green lawns and tree-lined roads. In addition to the Administrative, Student Support Services, Academic and AVPRC buildings, the campus has an extensive Plaza, a Conference Hall, an Auditorium and Guesthouse. The KU-Band earth station is also located on the University campus.

It is proposed to establish 10 permanent Regional Coordination Centres in the new districts formed in the Telangana State through an MoU with the Commissionerate, Collegiate Education, Telangana State.

ACHIEVEMENTS & MILESTONES

I am happy to share some of the achievements of the University with you all on this 23rd convocation of the university. The contribution of Open Distance Learning to the total enrolments in higher education has reached an impressive 11% in the recent years. Out of the total enrolment, BRAOU has a considerable share.

The University has received CSR Top Distance Learning Institutes of India Award for the years 2013 & 2014.

B.Sc. Program of the University is Ranked No.1 among India's Best Distance Learning Institutions by Careers-360 of 'Outlook' magazine.

University received Indus Foundation Award for Education Excellence for the year 2012 under Distance Education Category.

During the year, the University consolidated its ongoing Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for students with a vision of enhancing potential for employability, entrepreneurship and higher studies.

It gives me immense pleasure to share with you the achievements of some of our faculty members.

Prof. C. Venkataiah, Registrar & Professor of Public Administration, was awarded the Meritorious Teachers Award for the year 2018 by the Telangana State Government.

Dr. G. Pushpa Chakrapani, Director (GRADE) & Professor of Physics, received AAOU Fellowship for 2018 (Philippines Open University) & 2019 (Korea National Open University).

Dr. Vinay Sitapati, (Political Scientist, Journalist, Lawyer) Ashoka University, New Delhi the Author of "Half Lion" was the chief guest delivered a Lecture on "P. V. Narasimha Rao and Congress Party". Today Congress Party needs a Statesman like P. V. Narasimha Rao. The conditions prevailed during P. V. Narasinha Rao are same Prevailing now in the Congress Party, the party needs a strong Non-Gandhi and Non-Nehru family leadership. Now the Congress Party is led by old generation it is like old technology in new machine which is not sufficient to present scenario. To prevent NDA led BJP Govt. only possible with Congress Party no other Party in India, third biggest Party got around 6% of voting share in 2019 elections similarly, BJP got 38%, Congress 20% approximately.
